My dear Sir,

I have had great pleasure in being deputed to read your memoir on the Hindoos to the Royal Society of Litterature, and the Society is much indebted to you for such a testimony of Your regard. It will be printed in the Volume of their Transactions, which is now in the press. When may we hope [3] to see you again in this city . We have received a fearful <u>Secousse</u> since you visited us. The Reform of Parliament has spread over us an universal <u>mal-aise</u>, which Every succeeding year will I fear make more incurable.
